Walking Worthy: A Journey to Freedom (WW) is a 26 week support group ministry under the supervision of the Biblical Counseling Ministry of Woodland Park Baptist Church. Our method for providing personal assistance is based on the truths of the Word of God as applied through the philosophy of Exchanged Life, based on Galatians 2:20 and other scriptures related to our identity and sufficiency in Christ.

LAY FACILITATOR CREDENTIALS

Facilitators are laymen and laywomen not therapists. However, the Lay Facilitators shall be under the supervision of Woodland Park Baptist Church of Chattanooga. The Lay Facilitators have received training in listening and helping skills from Christian professionals who are trained in individual, marital, and family counseling. Lay Facilitators are not professionals in psychological counseling or psychiatric therapy and are not licensed. However they do receive supervision from a member of Woodland Park Baptist Church Pastoral Staff, who is under the authority of the Woodland Park General Council of Elders.

EXPECTED CONDUCT

- Being under the influence of alcohol or drugs during weekly group sessions is prohibited and may be grounds for termination of participation without refund of course fees.
- No weapons may be brought into the session.

ATTENDANCE

Your consistent participation in WW is critical in order to obtain the fruitful results God intends and you desire. No discretionary absences are allowed and only one excused absence is allowed per semester. If you are unable to be present at the group session, you will be required to make up the class BEFORE the next session (see Financial Policy).

CONFIDENTIALITY STATEMENT

The communication between you, your Facilitator and other support group members is considered confidential except as required by law, i.e. where there is a threat of serious harm to self or others, as in the case of child abuse, suicide or homicide.

ENROLLMENT AND FINANCIAL POLICY

Completing and signing this Participant Application, is your first step toward joining a WW class. The processing of applications may take up to 10 days. Please be sure the contact information listed is correct. You will be notified by US mail of your admission status. If you are not currently a part of other ministry areas of Woodland Park Baptist Church or if you are not currently involved in the Counseling Ministry of Woodland Park Baptist Church, an interview may be required before your acceptance is final.

WW is primarily underwritten by the members of Woodland Park Baptist Church of Chattanooga, Tennessee. Course fees paid by participants help offset expenses related to materials, handouts and other costs in creating and maintaining a high standard of excellence.

Applications will be accepted up to 10 days prior to the first day of class. Please check the church website or weekly bulletin for start dates and times. A non-fundable fee of \$50 is due with your application. The fee will be applied toward the cost of the class. Payment options are as follows:

- One Payment Plan: You may make one payment of \$350.00 payable the first day of class.
- Weekly Payment Plan: \$15 each week for a total of \$390.00. Please speak with your Facilitator or Co-Facilitator if you encounter difficulty paying each week. We will make every effort to work with you. There is no refund for missed sessions. Any missed sessions should be made up prior to the next session.
- Scholarships are available on a limited basis. Call the Counseling Ministry Office at 423.899-9186, x137 prior to the first day of class for more information.
- Discounts are available as follows:
 - Net income from \$20,000–\$29,000: \$10 per week
 - Net income from \$15,000–\$19,000: \$7 per week
 - Net income less than \$15,000: \$5 per week
 - Students repeating the class: \$195 (1/2 the regular price)

Note: a copy of your most recent pay stub/voucher or W-2 will be required to process discounts.
